We are using Rallyhood to help everyone associated with Girl Scouts of Gateway Council—families, volunteers, girls—to become better connected to each other.

A Rally is a digital space for groups, with collaboration features to help share information and coordinate events and activities. A Hub is a landing page with a grouping of related rallies under one umbrella. In our Gateway Council experience, we will utilize Rallies as the primary interaction space for volunteers and staff. All Gateway Council rallies will say "Gateway" after the topic area.

Ready to get started in Rallyhood? Here are the rallies we would recommend you start with:

Community and Troop Rallies: Each Community has their own Community Hub to connect with volunteers. Communities will have the option to create rallies for their own areas to connect with their troops, volunteers, and families. Troops are also able to set up their own Troop Rallies! Contact your Community Manager for assistance with creating a Rally for your troop.

Volunteer Roles and Troop Support Hub: This hub will provide rallies to support volunteers in many capacities of their role and beyond. Volunteers can request to join rallies that are a compliment to their role with Girl Scouts.

Girl Experience Hub: The Girl Experience Hub will have Rallies for various groups in GSGC that are not troop or community based, like our Highest Awards and Outdoors rallies.
